



FESTIVAL HOSPITALITY

Located in the Sheridan Opera House gallery, Festival Hospitality is the place to pick up your 3-Day pass and purchase official Telluride Horror Show memorabilia.

Theaters, Lines, and Individual Tickets

All films screen at either the Nugget Theatre or Sheridan Opera House. At both theaters, there are two lines: 1) Pass holders; 2) Individual ticket purchases. Individual tickets are \$10 each (unless otherwise noted) and are only sold at the door, after all pass holders have been admitted. Cash only.

STARTING TIMES

Doors open 15 minutes before show time. Access into the theater is no longer permitted once the film has started. This applies to all pass holders and individual ticket buyers. Don't be late!

THE Q SYSTEM

When lines start to form at theaters, our staff may issue Q tickets. Qs are handed out to determine how many people are waiting in line for a film. If capacity is reached for a show, those at the end of the line will be informed that the film is sold out. It's our way of making sure you don't wait in line, get turned away, and then miss the opportunity to see a film playing at the same time at the other theater.

TBAS (TO BE ANNOUNCED)

Several slots on Sunday at both theaters are kept open so we can show the more popular films at the festival twice, in case you didn't get to see them at their first screening. We will post the TBAs at the Nugget Theatre, Sheridan Opera House, and Hospitality on Sunday morning.



At the festival, Brad will be introducing films, conducting Q&As, and looking up pictures of baby animals.





BRIDE OF FRANKENSTEIN

USA 1935 | 75 min. | Director: James Whale SATURDAY, 4:30 PM, NUGGET THEATRE

"Warning! The monster demands a mate!" In James Whale's masterpiece, Dr. Frankenstein (goaded by an even madder scientist) builds his monster a bride. Experience Universal's classic horror movie on the big screen at the Telluride Horror Show! Presented in its original 35mm format with an introduction by Jon Davison.

THE LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS

USA 1960 | 70 min. | Director: Roger Corman FRIDAY, 5:30 PM, NUGGET THEATRE

A classic tale of boy-meets-girl, plant-eats-people, with Jack Nicholson in one of his first film roles. As Seymour's ruthless plant grows larger with each feeding, so does Seymour's affections for shop girl, Audrey. The madness culminates with Seymour and his bloodthirsty plant in a feeding frenzy of epic proportions. Director Roger Corman, the king of B-movies, shot this beat-era classic in a mere two days. It's the closing night at the last drive-in theater in America and Cecil B. Kaufman has planned the ultimate marathon of lost film prints to unleash upon his faithful cinephile patrons — four films so rare, they have never been exhibited publicly on American soil until this very night! What could possibly go wrong? In the spirit of classic anthology films like Creepshow and Twilight Zone: The Movie and comprising films that not only celebrate the golden age of drive-in B horror shlock but also span over five decades of cinema, CHILLERAMA offers something for every bad taste. With titles like Wadzilla, I Was a Teenage Werebear, The Diary of Anne Frankenstein, and Zom-B-Movie, not to mention appearances by Joel David Moore (Avatar), Lin Shaye (Insidious), Ray Wise (X-Men: First Class), Kane Hodder (Hatchet), and more cameos than you can count, CHILLERAMA is the ultimate midnight flick.

CHOP

USA 2010 | 85 min. | Director: Trent Haaga SATURDAY, 10:30 AM, NUGGETTHEATRE Lance is a normal guy living a normal life ... at least until "the stranger" enters. Now Lance is being tortured for a crime that he can't remember, everyone he loves is dying, he's losing his body parts, and there's no hope in sight unless Lance can remember what he's done. A bloody tale of revenge gone horribly wrong, a black comedy, and a satire of the torture porn sub-genre, CHOP is the directorial debut of Deadgirl screenwriter Trent Haaga.

DEADBALL

Baseball prodigy Jubeh Yakyu is the most feared and dangerous juvenile delinquent in all of Japan. After accidentally causing the death of his father with a super-powered, deadly fireball pitch, Jubeh swore off baseball and became a criminal. Now, at 17, he has been sent to the Pterodactyl Juvenile Reformatory for hardened criminals. Despite having sworn never to play baseball again, Jubeh is presented with an ultimatum by governor Mifune: Join the reformatory team, The Gauntlets, in the national tournament for juvenile inmates, or witness the death of his innocent cellmate Four Eyes. And so the splatterific baseball tournament begins! A hilariously offensive, politically incorrect sports splatter comedy, DEADBALL is director Yudai Yamaguchi's follow up to his earlier zombie baseball classic, Battlefield Baseball.

Two hitmen, Pinner and Cully, are assigned to murder Kist, an old associate of their boss. Breaking into his home in the dead of night, they sit down to wait for their quarry's return. To pass the time, Pinner begins to tell Cully a strange story from his past, but is interrupted by a noise outside. Investigating, they discover a makeshift black magic altar...and worse things besides. Cully begins to panic, but the hardened professional Pinner insists they stay and see the assignment through. Before long, Kist arrives home, and their job is soon complete. Or so it seems. For the two men have meddled with forces beyond their reckoning, and Pinner soon finds himself dealing with demons from within and without, as he is forced to battle for his very soul...assuming he still has one to lose.



CORALINE

USA 2009 | 100 min. | Director: Henry Selick SATURDAY, 1:00 PM, NUGGET THEATRE



LAIKA is an Oregon-based animation studio that produces features and shorts. From scratch. Their first stop-motion movie, CORALINE, was released to critical acclaim on February 6, 2009. Written and directed by Henry Selick (Nightmare Before Christmas, James and the Giant Peach), CORALINE is based on the novel by Neil Gaiman. The movie includes the voices of Dakota Fanning, Teri Hatcher and Ian McShane. The film was distributed by Focus Features.

After this special screening of CORALINE, LAIKA's Mark Shapiro will take us behind-

the-scenes of the Oscar-nominated film, the first stop-motion animated feature to be conceived and photographed in stereoscopic 3D. Experience a different perspective of CORALINE's animated world where intricate puppets and sets are meticulously hand-made and animated, frame by frame. Production puppets from the movie will be on display.

We're excited to have CORALINE and LAIKA at the Telluride Horror Show. Please, bring the kids to this show, but be advised: CORALINE is scary for younger children. If they have nightmares, don't blame us....

And the good news? LAIKA is sticking with the horror genre for its second stop-motion 3D feature, *ParaNorman*, coming to theaters on August 17, 2012. *ParaNorman*, a misunderstood boy who can speak with the dead, takes on ghosts, zombies and, worst of all, moronic grown-ups, in order to save his town from a centuries-old curse. We can't wait!

HELLDRIVER

Japan 2010 | 106 min. | Director: Yoshihiro Nishimura

A mysterious, alien-spawned mist blankets the northern half of Japan, transforming those who inhale it into ravenous, flesh-eating zombies hell-bent on devouring the surviving human population. Plunged into chaos, Japan is torn in two — where the populace remains untouched by the deadly gas, the southern half of the country lives behind a heavily-fortified wall, while the northern half is a lawless, zombie-infected wasteland. Political forces are locked in a stalemate over whether the living dead should remain protected as family members or exterminated like a plague. The economy withers away, and all hope seems lost for the people and the nation of Japan. Hope arrives in the form of Kika, a beautiful high school girl armed with a chainsaw sword powered by an artificial heart. Recruited by the government, Kika leads a ragtag group of desperados on a secret mission into the zombie-infected wilds to exterminate zombie queen Rikka and put an end to the plague of the living dead. Visionary filmmaker Yoshihiro Nishimura's first solo directorial effort since *Tokyo Gore Police*, HELLDRIVER is an epic, apocalyptic road movie featuring non-stop action and over-the-top splatter.

MONSTER BRAWL

Canada 2011 | 88 min. | Director: Jesse Thomas Cook SATURDAY, 10:30AM, SHERIDAN OPERA HOUSE (U.S. PREMIERE)

It's midnight at the Hillside Necropolis. The stage is set for the first-ever Monster Brawl. Eight of the world's most legendary monsters compete in a fight-to-the-death wrestling tournament to determine the most powerful champion of all time. Interviews, pre-fight breakdowns, trash-talking and monster origin segments round out this ultimate fight of the living dead. MONSTER BRAWL features an ensemble cast of comedy, horror and wrestling icons, including Dave Foley (Kids in the Hall), Art Hindle (The Brood), Lance Henriksen (Aliens), Robert Maillet (Sherlock Holmes), Kevin Nash (The Punisher), Herb Dean (UFO), and Jimmy Hart (WWE).

SUNDAY, 11:30 AM, NUGGET THEATRE (SUBTITLED)

A brother and sister in their twenties run away from home after their dark secret is discovered. They find temporary refuge in a deserted nature reserve. When the sister falls into a hunting trap set by a psychotic killer, the brother sets out in a race against time to rescue her. A forest ranger and his old dog, two apathetic cops, four tennis players and a murderer wandering carefree amongst his traps will all be gradually drawn into a whirlwind of misunderstandings, fears and violence.

THE REVENANT

USA 2011 | 115 min. | Director: Kerry Prior FRIDAY, 10:15 PM, NUGGETTHEATRE

Bart is killed in the Middle East but inexplicably awakens and climbs from his grave; confused and horrified — he's a moldy, putrefying living corpse — a Revenant. He enlists the help of his best friend Joey and they learn that Bart must consume human blood to keep from decomposing. The discovery sends them on a satirical quest through the streets of LA and drives them to commit acts neither thought possible. Bart and Joey become "The Vigilante Gun-Slingers," cruising the streets in a '79 Camaro with a surfboard on the roof, causing mayhem and chaos for those they come across. As their world collapses upon them, they must confront issues of morality, immortality, the bounds of friendship, and the nature of evil. THE REVENANT was a huge hit on the 2009 festival circuit, garnering numerous rewards and outstanding reviews. Yet it hasn't been released. That's all about to change later this fall. The 2011 release cut is being finished as we speak, and THE REVENANT's official release is imminent. We're proud to give the film one more festival screening before it's let loose on the world!

After countless pleas and threatening phone calls, we gave in: TUCKER & DALE vs. EVIL, the stand-out hit of the 2010 Telluride Horror Show, returns to the big screen one more time. This hilariously gory, good-spirited horror comedy does for killer rednecks what *Shaun of the Dead* did for zombies. Tucker and Dale, two best friends on vacation at their dilapidated mountain house, are mistaken for murderous backwoods hillbillies by a group of obnoxious, preppy college kids. When one of the students gets separated from her friends, the boys try to lend a hand, but as the misunderstanding grows, so does the body count.

THE SCARLET WORM

A hired gun named Print is obsessed with adding style and poetry to his assassinations. He has been working with loyalty for his boss, Mr. Paul, for years. But his latest assignment — the killing of a brothel owner who mandates cruel abortions on his whores — presents two challenges: He must train a young understudy during the assignment, and he's been told to pull off the killing "quick and dirty" — which may not leave time for Print's usual, obsessively imaginative methods.

SENNENTUNTSCHI

Switzerland 2010 | 110 min. | Director: Michael Steiner FRIDAY, 7:30 PM, NUGGET THEATRE (SUBTITLED)

The Swiss Alps, 1975: In a remote mountain village, a woman of wild beauty appears out of nowhere. The village policeman Reusch is the only one who openly approaches the mute woman in an attempt to find out who she is. It becomes apparent that she has travelled from Höhenalp, where Alpine herdsmen do unimaginable things to attract female company and thus combat their solitude. An affliction that would have remained undiscovered gradually comes to light, and a story of desire, madness and murder jeopardizes the village's apparent idyll. It is the beginning of a nightmare filled with sanctimonious madness, hypocrisy, abuse and demonism that threatens to end the dreams of two lovers and drag the whole village into the abyss.


